Some of the many benefits of sport participation for children include:

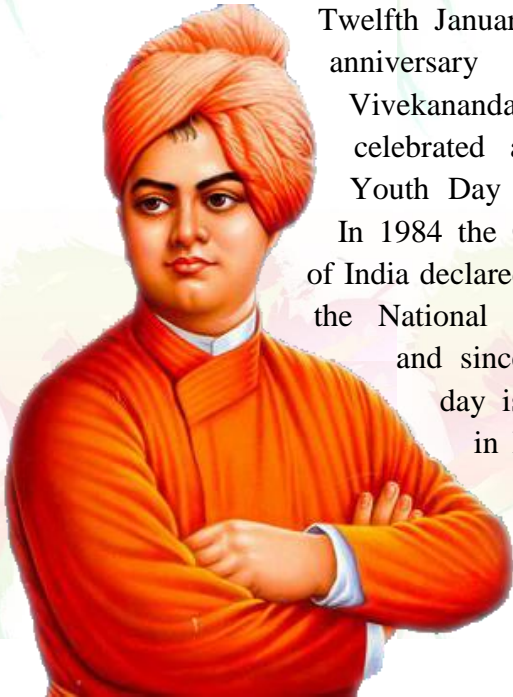
- Reduced risk of obesity.
