In 1774, Louis xvi of the Bourbon family ascended the throne. Long years of war had drained the financial resources of France. Added to this was the cost of maintaining an extravagant court at the immense palace of Versailles. He helped the thirteen American colonies to gain their independence from the common enemy, Britain.

23.2: Source B

The members of the Jacobin club belonged mainly to the less prosperous sections of society. They include small shopkeepers, artisans such as shoemakers, pastry cooks, watchmakers, printers, as well as servants and daily-wage workers.

23.3: Source C

The colonies in Caribbean-Martinique, Guadeloupe and San Domingo-were important suppliers of Commodities such as tobacco, indigo, sugar and coffee. But the reluctance of Europeans to go and work in distant and unfamiliar lands meant a shortage of labour on the plantations.

So, this was met by a triangular slave trade between Europe, Africa and the Americas.
